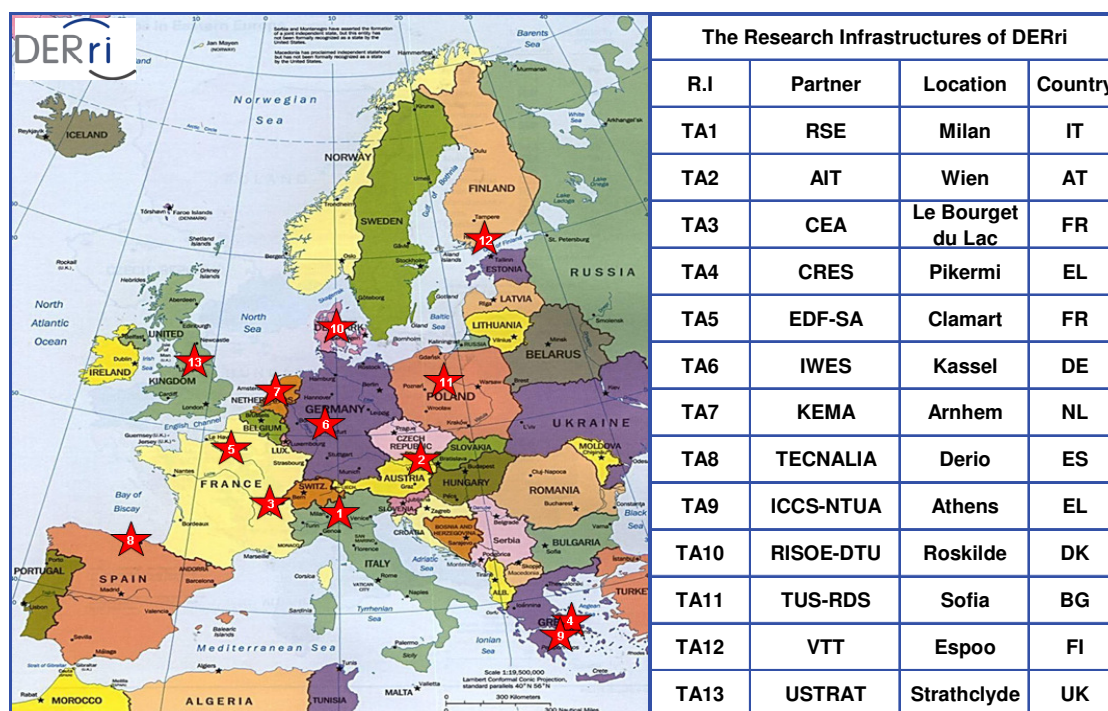

CALL FOR PROPOSAL FOR FREE-OF-CHARGE ACCESS TO INFRASTRUCTURES FOR EXPERIMENTAL RESEARCH IN THE FIELD OF DISTRIBUTED ENERGY RESOURCES (DER)

The EU DERri project hereby invites relevant research groups ('User Groups') to submit a proposal for specific **free-of-charge**¹ access ('Transnational Access') to utilise the DERri partners excellent Research Infrastructures to support their research activities within the field of distributed energy resources.

The DERri project, a consortium supported under the European FP7 programme, includes 16 partners with 13 different DER Research Infrastructures, located in 12 different European countries and equipped with synergetic and complementary Test Facilities.

Calls for transnational accesses will be announced every 6 months in the period 2010 – 2013.

The eighth deadline for submission of a proposal is: **30 November 2012**
